The Town of Moorcroft is requesting sealed Bids for the construction of the following project:

Town of Moorcroft Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Facilities

Moorcroft Landfill #3 Closure Project

Bids for the construction of the project will be received by the Town of Moorcroft, at 108 South Little Horn Avenue, Moorcroft WY 82721, until the following time and date:

2:00 PM on May 7th, 2026.

At that time, the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project is generally described as:

Closure of an approximately 10-acre municipal solid waste landfill, owned and operated by the Town of Moorcroft and located approximately 6 miles east of the Town. Once construction begins, 60 working days are allotted to complete this project and must fall within the 180-day closure period window. The landfill shall be subgrade-prepped, a final soil cover passive gas venting system installed, and topsoil vegetated. The site shall be fitted with temporary erosion control during construction.

The Project consists of the following Work:

1. Waste excavation and relocation.
2. Excavation of onsite soils for use as structural fill.
3. Installation of passive landfill gas venting system.
4. Placement of onsite soils for final cover system in conformance with proposed final closure grades.
5. Topsoiling and seeding of disturbed areas.
6. Erosion and sediment controls.
7. Installation of fence.

Bids will be received for a single prime contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis as indicated on the Bid Form. Unit prices and estimated quantities are solely for the purpose of comparing bids. Pursuant to Wyoming Statue (W.S.) 15-1-113(f), each qualified bid must be accompanied by a bid security equal to 5% of the total bid amount. For bids exceeding \$150,000, the bid security must be in the form of a bid bond. The successful bidder shall furnish performance and payment bonds, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price, as a condition of contract execution as per W.S. 15-1-113(d) and (f).
